

Release of Liability Waiver- Instructions for Troupe Directors

Greetings Troupe Directors. In an effort to improve Shifting Sands Belly Dance, we are going to try out a new system of handing out wrist bands for troupes. We have provided instructions for you so that it will help make this an easier process for everyone.

1. Provide a list of all the performers/persons in your group that you will be picking up wrist bands for. If you are not picking up for your entire group, please let the remainder of the performers know that they **MUST** pick-up their wrist bands at the Renaissance Festival set-up on the Thursday before. No exceptions without consent from the Board of Directors.
2. Please have everyone Print, Sign, and Date the Liability Waiver form and return it the President or designated representative at the Renaissance Festival set-up on Thursday.
3. If you, the Troupe Director, are not going to be the person picking up the wrist bands, please inform the Board ahead of time on who is going to be picking them up on behalf of your troupe.
4. SSBD requires every person performing/camping/volunteering to bring one (1) gallon of water on Thursday of set-up or prior to the start of each morning during the event. Please bring your troupe's water donation. If you require assistance unloading, please let us know so we can assist.
5. Volunteering is very important to the success of the event as a whole. All persons (not including minors) are required to sign up for one (1) shift. Prior to you picking up wrist bands for your troupe, we will verify that all persons receiving wristbands have met this requirement.
6. Please ensure your troupe is thoroughly informed of the encampment, performance, and park rules. There is a rules companion that can be found on the SSBD webpage for your convenience.
